

PARENT NOTIFICATION

The School District recognizes the importance of regular communication with parents or guardians. Communication with parents or guardians should occur on a regular basis regarding student progress and school events. In addition, general information is sent to all parents or guardians at various times during the year, including the District School Calendar, District Newsletters, and the Executive Summary of the District Code of Conduct. There are also instances that occur during the year which require notification to parents or guardians involving single classrooms, buildings, or the entire District. Typical communications include:

1. Head Lice – if a student in the classroom is determined to be infected, a letter is sent home to parents or guardians of all students in that classroom.
2. Parents or guardians of students in an entire building will be notified in cases of a bomb threat, damage to a building or property which might cause a hazard, an intruder incident which involves law enforcement, the arrest of an adult in school or on school property, or the discovery of fire arms or explosives in the building.
3. All parents or guardians will be notified at the direction of the Chief School Physician regarding communicable diseases.
