

### COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

The Board of Education is devoted to the development, implementation and maintenance of a comprehensive year-round community relations program to enhance a better understanding of the educational program, and to provide for the broadest participation of all -- Board, staff, students, and community – in seeking solutions to problems and in promoting the continuing improvement of the educational resources available to the school community.

To this end, the Board establishes the following goals for community involvement:

1. to promote an active partnership and spirit of cooperation between the school and the citizens, businesses, and community agencies in which professional educators and community members work together toward the successful implementation of the total educational program;
2. to share resources with civic and community organizations; particularly in the development and implementation of programs designed to benefit students;
3. to promote staff awareness of community needs and expectations and encourage volunteer participation by students, parents, and staff to make the community a better place to live;
4. to foster public understanding of the need for constructive change, and solicit public advice on how the district can best achieve its educational goals.
