

BLOOD BORNE PATHOGEN EXPOSURE CONTROL

The Board acknowledges the need to protect staff members and students from health risks related to blood borne pathogens. The Superintendent shall maintain standards and practices in compliance with federal and state statutes for blood borne pathogens.

The Superintendent shall maintain, and all school staff shall comply with, Universal Precautions for dealing with all exposure to blood and other body fluids in or on school premises or during school activities. The District shall consult public health officials, as appropriate, for the most current methods and information pertaining to such procedures.
