*pencil box

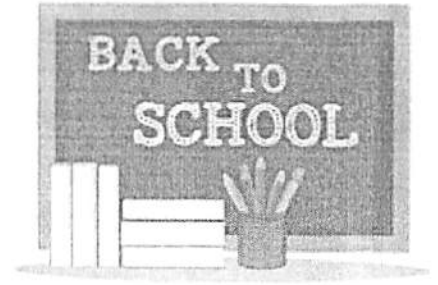

Supply List for Carder School 2nd Grade



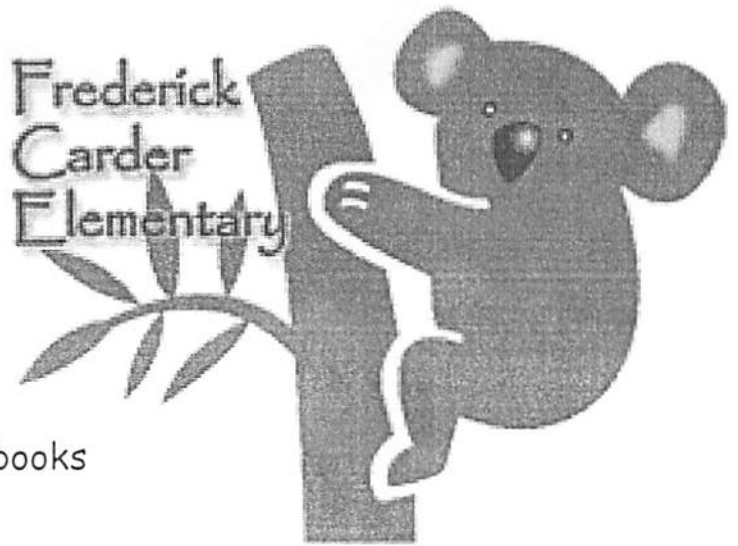
- 24 plain pencils (Ticonderoga #2) -
(these will be shared by ALL students)
- 1 pack of (Crayola) *Twistable Crayons* (they may be more expensive, but they never break and never need sharpening. They will also be usable for 3rd grade, too!)
- 1 pair of scissors*
- 2 glue sticks* - (NO bottled glue)
- 1 highlighter*
- 1 hard plastic crayon box to hold all of the above*
- 2 horizontal pocket folders* (the plastic/vinyl folders do last all year)
- 1 package of BLACK Dry Erase markers (Expo)
- Optional: headphones for laptop computers*
- Snacks - (each child needs to bring in their own healthy snack each day)

Please note: The brand names in parenthesis are preferred, because they are better products and longer lasting.

*Please label all asterisked items with your child's name or initials. A permanent marker works the best.

In August, you will receive a letter from your 2nd grade teacher and they may be asking you to purchase a few more additional items.

Supply List Third Grade



- 12 (#2) pencils
- 1-Marble Composition Notebooks
- Colored Pencils
- 24 pack of Crayons
- 1- Pair of Student Scissors
- 1- Glue Stick
- 1- Pencil Box (standard size)
- 1- Ruler
- 1- Yellow Highlighter
- You'll need a few folders, too- but wait until you get a letter in August from your teacher.

The following items are optional, but many students have preferred having headphones and a mouse to use with Chromebooks. This could be a one time purchase that can move through the grades with your child.

- Headphones/ ear buds (whatever they are most comfortable with)
- Wireless mouse

Please do not send:

- Trapper Keeps
 - 3-ring notebooks
 - bottles of glue
- (We don't have room in our desks.)



Fourth Grade Recommended Supply List



A general supply list was sent home at the end of last school year. If you haven't had a chance to pick up the items, I've included the list again.

Recommended School Supplies:

- 1-pack No. 2 pencils-Please sharpen pencils prior to the first day of school.
- 1-small pencil sharpener w/shavings holder (manual)
- 1-pack of multicolored highlighters
- 2-3 red pens
- 1-eraser or several cap erasers
- 1-pack of colored pencils (twistable kind recommended)
- 2-packs sticky notes (approx. size 3" x 3")
- 1 pack of sticky note flags
- 1-2 packs of dry-erase markers with erasers
- 1-fabric pencil case (plastic boxes are not recommended)
- 1-pair headphones/earbuds (optional)

These are **additional** supplies your child will need at the start of 4th grade:

- 2 single subject **spiral** notebooks (please purchase **blue** and **red**)
- 4 two pocket folders (1 of each color - **blue**, **red**, **green**, and **yellow**)
- 1 **purple** two pocket folder **with fasteners**
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 ruler (1/4 and 1/2 inch on one side and centimeters on the other side)

Please note: These are the actual colors I would like each student to have. We color-coordinate our notebooks and folders with each subject.

Please do not bring in Trapper Keepers, 3 ring binders, or plastic pencil boxes. They are too large and take up too much space in the desks. Thank you!!

Grade 5

- 3 binders (size - 1 inch)
- Pencils (#2) ...need 2-3 daily
- 1 package of loose leaf paper
- 2-3 pens any color
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 highlighter

Optional:

- lightweight headphones for the Chromebook (place in Ziploc bag labeled with name)
- 1 or 2 vinyl erasers (usually white) Pentel or Steadtler Hi-Polymer are best
- pencil sharpener
- scissors
- 1 glue stick
- 1 roll clear tape
- 1 pad- sticky notes (3 in. size)
- 1 small fabric pencil case

*Many of these items will need replenishing throughout the school year.
