



Erwin Valley Elementary First Grade Supply List 2017-2018

3 dozen Ticonderoga number 2 pencils (Please, only purchase the Ticonderoga brand. All other brands break school pencil sharpeners)

2 brick erasers

6 glue sticks

1 pair of children's scissors (Fiskars are great!)

1 box of 16 crayons (Please no more than that!)

1 box of washable markers

1 box of 12 twistable color pencils

1 5x9 plastic pencil box (Please write your child's name on it.)

2 plastic two-pocket folders (Please write your child's name on folders.)

1 backpack (If you know your child's dismissal bus number, please label the number on the backpack.)

1 package of 8 fine tip Expo markers in red, blue, green, or black

1 pair of inexpensive headphones.
(Headphones are usually available at dollar stores for a dollar.)

Pencils, erasers, expo markers and glue sticks will be placed in community baskets.

Supply List

Welcome to second grade! It is a dynamic year of growth and mini-miracles. It is a year filled with fun and adventure. You can help, by supplying your child with the following items on the first day of school.

- 1 - 2 dozen pencils (Plain, yellow, wooden pencils only please. We will be sharing them.)
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 small bottle of white glue
- 1 pair of scissors (No pointed ones please)
- 1 box of 24 crayons (No larger) **OR** A package of Crayola Twistable colored pencils (No neon colors please. You should be able to find them in the Crayola aisles at Walmart or Target.)
- 2 large pink block erasers or cap erasers
- 2 pocket folder (The plastic ones hold up the best.)
- 1 or 2 dry erase markers (no yellow)
- 1 plastic pencil box approximately 5" x 9"
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 2 black dry erase markers
- Optional - Headphones for the computer lab/Chromebooks.

Supply List for Third Grade

I have listed the school supplies needed to start our year. Students in our classroom do not have desks, but will use tubs for supply storage that have enough room for only those items I have requested. Unneeded supplies will be sent home. Please try to label supplies with stickers or permanent marker.

Supplies needed:

Composition book (marbled, hardcover)

Pencils (3 dozen)-Please send **Papermate, Ticonderoga, or quality wooden pencils only.** **NO** plastic-coated or foil decorative pencils. They ruin the pencil sharpeners. Please consider sending in some extra pencils for our "community pencil can."

Colored pencils (package of 8-12 is fine) or Twistables

2 two-pocket folders

2 glue sticks

Pencil/supply box- Plastic snap lid, about 9" by 5" OR zippered pouch(es).

Scissors-Student-sized for larger 3rd grade hands.

Optional

Computer headphones in a labeled Ziploc bag

Medium or fine point dry erase markers-black only

Supply List for Grade 4 - Haischer/Markayze/Bethka

Please bring the following supplies, labeled with your child's name:

- Scissors
