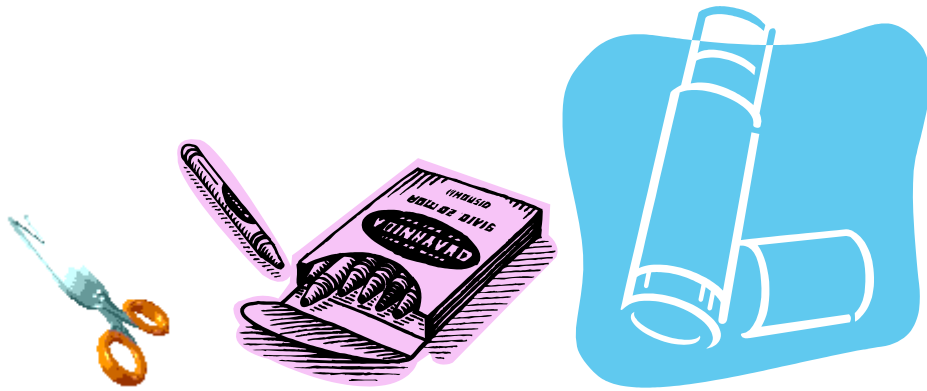


Supply List for Gregg School Kindergarten



- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (8 only)
- 1 pack of thin Crayola markers
- 1 pack of thick Crayola markers
- 1 packages of baby wipes

Welcome to 1st Grade

There are a few items you will need to prepare yourself for 1st grade. We wanted you to have the list of items so that when the sales begin you are ready to shop.

Items that you will keep in your desk ...

- one soft pencil/crayon **bag** (for your markers)
- one box of 24 crayons (no more than 24 please)
- a pair of scissors
- one package of **washable** markers

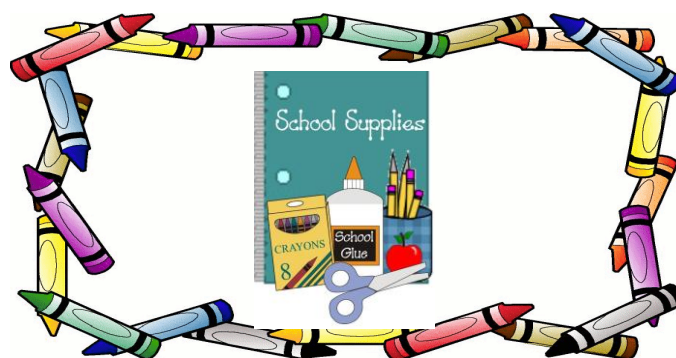
Items that you will share with classmates ...

- 24 Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- one package of thin dry erase markers
- one package of thin highlighters
- 10 glue sticks
- a container of baby wipes OR disinfectant cleaning wipes (we use both a lot!)

***We use Chromebook computers at least once a week and ask that you send in a pair of inexpensive headphones (not earbuds) to school with your child. Each student keeps their headphones in a separate Ziploc bag - we do not share headphones. They will be sent home at the end of the school year.

The best time to buy school supplies is in August and September. It is best to buy extra crayons, glue sticks and pencils because we may need more as early as January. This way you won't have to pay full price later.

SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST

This is a general list to help you get started:

- Hard plastic pencil box
- Small box traditional #2 **real wood** pencils with erasers (Ticonderoga brand pencils work best); these will be community pencils.
- Package of black, fine-point dry erase markers (Expo brand have no fumes)
- Hand-held eraser (marked with your name or initials)
- 16 or 24 box of crayons or Twistables
- 1 orange and 1 blue **2-pocket** folders
- $\frac{1}{2}$ or 1 inch 3-ring binder
- Box of tissues
- Quart size Hefty **Slider** bags (not Ziplock)
- Container of disinfectant cleaning wipes

Please do not purchase additional items that are not on this list until you receive your welcome letter. Any "extras" will be sent back home.

In the welcome letter that comes in the summer, you will see a few other added supplies that your specific classroom teacher will need you to have.

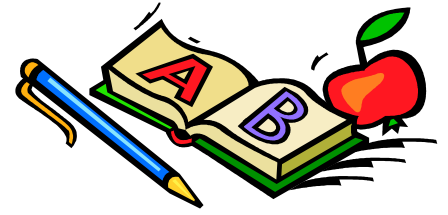

- 20 traditional wooden pencils with erasers ***
- 2 hand-held pencil erasers ***
- a box of 16 or 24 crayons or colored pencils (please, no more than 24!) ***
- 1 highlighter
- a small-sized pencil box
- 4 folders with pockets
- 2 glue sticks ***
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 package of WIDE ruled notebook paper
- 3-4 FINE point dry erase markers (not the chisel point please)
- 1 unneeded sock (or piece of felt) to use as an eraser with the dry erase markers
