

The IB Middle Years Program Curriculum Model

Students in the IB Middle Years Program (MYP) take courses in eight subject groups:

- [Language B](#) (French or Spanish)

- [Sciences](#)
- [Physical Education](#)

Students study their core subjects through the five [Areas of Interaction](#). It's helpful to think of these as a set of "lenses" teachers use to help students "see" the connections between their regular classroom subjects, as well as between what they learn at school and "the real world." The Areas of Interaction include:

- Approaches to Learning
- Human Ingenuity
- Community and Service
- Health and Social Education
- Environments

In addition, all MYP students create a [Personal Project](#) [[link to Margie's pages](#)] in 10th grade as the capstone of the curriculum. This is a significant piece of work that is the product of the student's own initiative and creativity. Students are expected to choose their project, which can take many forms, and take the process through to completion under the supervision of a mentor.
