Nominating Petitions Are Now Available

CORNING, NY - Nominating petitions for three Corning-Painted Post School Board of Education vacancies are currently available. Interested individuals may pick up petitions from Karen Dutcher, District Clerk, at the Administration Building, 165 Charles Street, Painted Post, N.Y.

A Board of Education Member's term of office is three years and School Board Members draw no salary or compensation. To qualify as a candidate for the School Board, School Board Members must be at least eighteen years of age, a citizen of the United States, a qualified voter of the Corning City School District, and have resided within the District for at least one year immediately preceding the election.

The deadline for filing the completed petitions with the School District Clerk is 5 p.m. on April 28, 2010. The election is scheduled for Tuesday, May 18, 2010.

Signatures of 100 eligible voters of the school district are required on each petition. People signing a nominating petition must be 18 years of age, a U.S. Citizen, a registered voter and have resided in the School District for 30 days preceding the election. People must sign the petition as his or her signature appears on the registration rolls.
