C-PP Seeks Subscribers For E-Updates

CORNING, NY – The Corning-Painted Post Area School District is now offering convenient, earth-friendly and effective delivery of news and updates to District residents, families and the general public. By subscribing through a link on the C-PP website at www.corningareaschools.com/enewsletters/, users can sign up to receive news from the School District directly to their home or business e-mail address.

“We are excited to announce the availability of our electronic news subscription,” said Superintendent Mike Ginalski. He added, “Subscribers to this service will be among the first to learn about important news, updates and press releases. Those who subscribe will receive bulletins highlighting interesting activities held in C-PP schools, as well as delivery of District newsletters. In addition, subscribers can elect to receive e-mail messages announcing emergency school closings or delays, giving access to real-time information about school status.”

The subscription process is simple, convenient and fast. Internet users can access the subscription page of the C-PP website by browsing to www.corningareaschools.com/enewsletters/. Then, they check the boxes next to the e-news they wish to receive, type their e-mail address in the designated box and click on the “subscribe” button. An automatically generated e-mail message provides a link to follow to verify the subscriber’s e-mail address. Once the verification link is clicked, the process is complete. It takes a total of about one minute to complete the steps. Subscribers will begin to receive District news on a timely basis as an e-mail message, possibly with an attachment.

“We know that many people prefer to receive news electronically, so we are pleased to be able to offer this communications tool to our District families and residents,” said Mr. Ginalski. “I encourage everyone to subscribe today at www.corningareaschools.com. It literally only takes a minute.”
