It is hereby determined that said vote on the proposition was held in all respects in the manner prescribed by the Education Law of the State of New York.

They have this day met, December 16, 2009, after due notification, at the Administration Building at 165 Charles Street, Painted Post, New York, in the evening, have received from the Clerk of the Board of Education the respective Statements of the Inspectors of Election of all the election districts, have examined said Statements of the results of the proposition and have tabulated them, as per attached.

The Board has this day canvassed the returns as contained in such statements and hereby determines the number of votes cast for the resolution according to the attachment.


Shall the Bond Resolution of the City School District of the City of Corning entitled: "Bond Resolution of the City School District of the City of Corning, New York, adopted October 28, 2009, authorizing the construction of additions, alterations and improvements to District buildings and the sites thereof (the "Project"), stating the estimated total cost thereof is \$174,350,000; appropriating said amount therefor; authorizing the issuance of \$174,350,000 serial bonds of said District to finance said appropriation; stating that the obligations (serial bonds and bond anticipation notes) to be issued pursuant to this bond resolution may be issued in excess of the constitutional debt limitation of the District; and further stating that any reimbursement aid received from the State of New York shall be applied to offset the cost of the Project and/or reduce the amount of taxes required to be levied."
