

Attention Hugh Gregg Elementary School parents and guardians:

## Parent drop-off/pick-up traffic pattern changes planned for 2019-20

Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, there will be a significant change to the traffic flow through the parent drop-off/pick-up loop at Hugh Gregg Elementary School. The goal is to increase safety and also improve efficiency of this daily process. This decision was reached with input from parents, Gregg School's Resource Officer Deputy Kimmey, Corning Police, and the CPP District/Gregg School Safety Teams.

The original design of the loop and parking area allowed for two way traffic on the south side of the loop and one way traffic on the north side of the loop. On several occasions, this created unsafe situations for drivers and pedestrians. The installed signage inadequately alerted drivers of the traffic flow and eventually was not reinstalled after being hit many times.

We advise drivers to familiarize themselves with this new process for 2019-20. If you have any questions, please contact me.

- Beginning August 26<sup>th</sup>, vehicles must **enter the loop** from Sly Avenue at the north entrance, the one **closest to the school**.
- Vehicles will move in a **counterclockwise** direction.
- Vehicles must **exit the loop** from the south exit, the one **closest to the North Baptist Church**.
- Cars that park in the spaces on the church/field side of the lot will drive around the loop to access those spaces.
- The painted arrows on the blacktop are being updated to reflect this change.
- There are no changes to the traffic pattern in the Flint Avenue parking lot.
