**Immunization Requirements for Students in Grades 6-10**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Date: February 28, 2018

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

**Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 6-10**

<b>Immunization</b>	<b>Number of Doses</b>
<b>Tdap:</b> Boostrix® & Adacel®	<b>1</b>
<b>DTaP/DTP</b>	<b>3</b>
<b>Varicella (chickenpox)</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>Polio</b>	<b>4 doses</b> or <b>3 doses</b> if the 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose was received at age 4 or older
<b>MMR</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>Hep B</b>	<b>3 doses or</b> 2 doses of adult hepatitis B vaccine (Recombivax)
<b>MenACWY:</b> Menactra® & Menveo®	<b>1 dose</b> Grade 7 or 8* or 9*
	* Most of the students in grade 8 and 9 will have already received the MENACWY vaccine dose in grade 7, unless transferred from out of state or out of country. MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 10.
