



Immunization Requirements for Pre-Kindergarten Students

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter Pre-kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

Required Immunizations for Pre-Kindergarten

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	3
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	4
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	1
Varicella (Chickenpox)	1
Hemophilus Influenzae	1 to 4
Pneumococcal Conjugate	1 to 4

Proof of immunization should be sent to the school nurse where your child will be attending pre-kindergarten.

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases
 - For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.

If your student participates in the special education preschool program at Severn Elementary School or a preschool program at ASA/CCA/Christian Hope please contact one of the numbers below.

Immunization Requirements for Students in Kindergarten-grade 5

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

Required Immunizations for Kindergarten-grade 5

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	4 doses or 3 if the 3rd dose at 4 years of age or older
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5 doses or 4 if the 4th dose given at 4 years of age or older or 3 doses if series started at age 7 or older
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2

Please send proof of immunization to the school nurse where your child will be attending school.

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases
 - For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.

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Immunization Requirements for Students in Grades 6-10

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 6-10

Immunization	Number of Doses
Tdap: Boostrix® & Adacel®	1
DTaP/DTP	3
Varicella (chickenpox)	2
Polio	4 doses or 3 doses if the 3 rd dose was received at age 4 or older
MMR	2
Hep B	3 doses or 2 doses of adult hepatitis B vaccine (Recombivax)
MenACWY: Menactra® & Menveo®	1 dose Grade 7 or 8* or 9*
	* Most of the students in grade 8 and 9 will have already received the MENACWY vaccine dose in grade 7, unless transferred from out of state or out of country. MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 10.

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 11-12

Immunization	Number of Doses
Tdap: Boostrix® & Adacel®	1
DTaP/DTP	3
Varicella (chickenpox)	1
Polio	3 doses
MMR	2
Hep B	3 doses or 2 doses of adult hepatitis B vaccine (Recombivax)
MenACWY: Menactra® & Menveo®	By Grade 12: 2 doses or 1 dose if the dose was received at age 16 or older
	* Note: MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 11.
